12.50 pm On arrival at Bethesda Arcade, Marc and his guests will hear your chosen pieces of music being played by your Musician, Scott Kacenga, and you will be welcomed by your Photographer Vito Kwan and his team from Jasmine Photo and your Web Technician

who will be ready and waiting to Live stream your Wedding to everybody back home!

The Bridal Party having being met by Hollie Eryes (Wedding Coordinator) at the W.72nd St & Central Park West entrance of Central Park will all then make the 10-15 minute walk to Bethesda Arcade.
